
Nursing Assistant Program Commitment / Consideration Process

- Student requirements
 - Valid Social Security Number
 - No more than 6 absences per year
 - Passing score of 75% Class & Clinical
 - Passing score of 75% on each unit test (retakes allowed)
 - Passing score of 87% on written final exams
 - 95% minimal on clinical evaluations and final practical test
 - Actively engaged in unit assignment / activity

Credits

- Glendale Union High School District
 - 2 high school credits
- Glendale Community College (Fall)
 - Dual enrollment Program
 - 75% required to pass community college courses.



Grading Scale


In an effort to ensure students are achieving at their highest potential and to better prepare students for the state certification exams, HCE uses an advanced proficiency grading scale.



$$A = 100 - 90$$

$$D = 69 - 60$$

Requirements for Clinicals


- Students must maintain optimum health throughout the program.
- CPR for Health Care Provider and maintain current status throughout the program.
- Level 1 Fingerprint Clearance Card/Background Check
- TB Test
- Completion of all forms and necessary training required by hospital or healthcare facility
- Flu shot during time required by hospital or healthcare facility
- Physical examination
- Immunization Record
- Random drug testing
